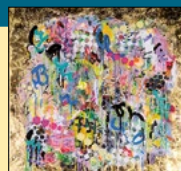
If you're a magpie for gold and a lover of colour, come and explore my paint-splattered studio – one artist, big statement abstracts.

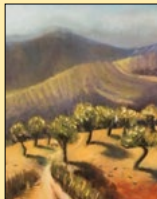

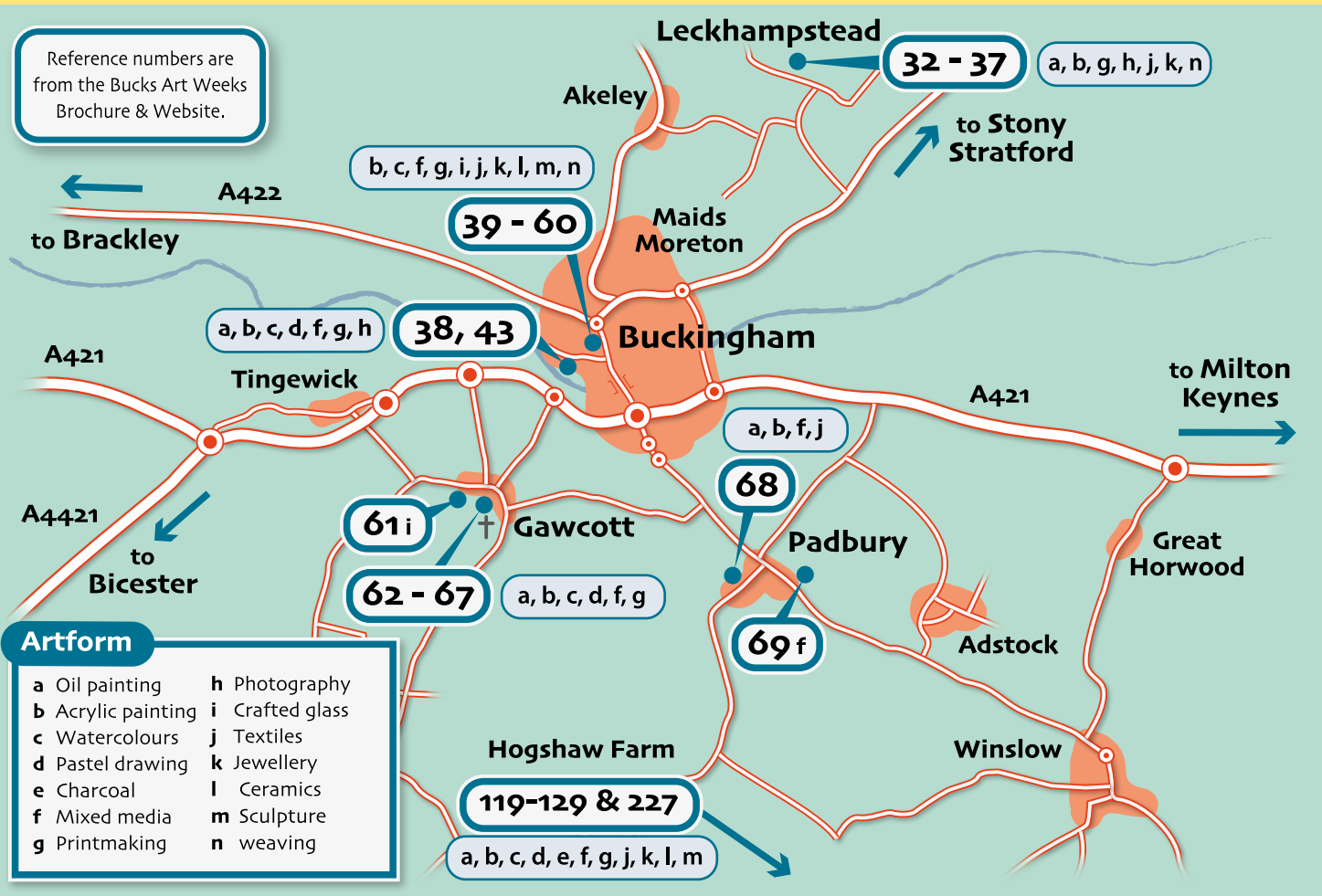
