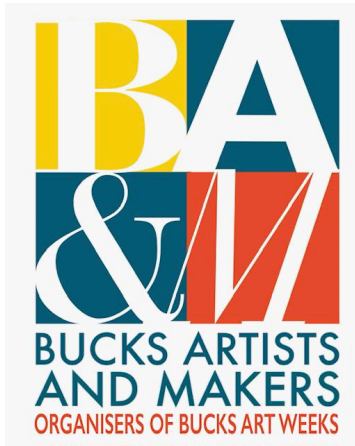




HUGHENDEN MANOR ART EXHIBITION

Artist Information

This exhibition is an exciting opportunity to exhibit your artwork at a local National Trust venue which attracts a huge number of visitors each year. This exhibition will take place as part of Heritage Open Days 2026, offering free access to National Trust locations between 11-20th September.

All Bucks Artists and Makers members are invited to apply (you do not need to have taken part in BAW) but acceptance will be based on media & style. For example, if we already have a number of landscape artists exhibiting, an abstract artist, who may have applied later, will be chosen to exhibit. This way we can present a good variety of media and artwork styles.

An email will be sent out after the August deadline to inform artists if they have been successful.

We hope that you appreciate that this is being arranged by artists for artists and we do need your help to make the exhibition work - artists will be required to commit a certain amount time to help steward the space for the duration of the show as well as helping us to put up/take down display boards. It is a great way to interact with the public and increase sales.

Nearer the time we will be asking you to indicate 4 sessions (half days) when you will be available to steward the exhibition – this is to make sure we have enough people to cover for the duration. We will try to share the time out equally. Please ensure you are able to make this commitment when applying.

We will also allocate timed slots for the set up and take down so please ensure you are available on Thursday 10th and Mon 21st September,

SUBMISSION FEES

£35 plus 25% commission on all sales

- 2D artists will be allocated a 4 x 4 foot display board, 3D artists will be supplied a 1100mm x 550mm table for their artwork.
- All artists are encouraged to bring extra artwork that can be held in reserve and used to replace sales.
- Artists must supply their own browsers and these will be placed in front of display boards.
- Only traditional folding browsers are allowed.

PRESENTATION

- 2D artwork must be adequately prepared for hanging with wire/string from 'D' or 'O' rings.
- Frames must be of presentable appearance and of saleable quality as befitting a professional exhibition. Clip-art frames are not acceptable.
- 3D artists must provide a white tablecloth/sheet to cover their table. Please help us maintain the presentation of the exhibition by making sure this is ironed.
- Browsers must be supplied to display prints/originals and be labelled with the artist's name.
- 3D artists showing small work, such as jewellery, may want to bring lockable cabinets and leave the key for Stewards.
- All work must have either a label/sticker on the back (or base if 3D) with:
 - a) Artist's name
 - b) The name of the work (as on the Catalogued/Uncatalogued form)
 - c) PriceAll typed or written clearly (preferably in block capitals)
- All work must have a label attached to the front with the same details – label template will be provided.
- Greeting Cards – All cards must be sold at the same price and no offers are to be made (i.e Buy 1,Get 1 Free).

- All cards need to have a sticker on the back showing the price and the artists name needs to be easily seen (either printed on the card or on the sticker).
- A small stand/box to hold the cards must be provided by the artist and labelled on the back with their name – artists are allowed up to 50 cards. The cards may be positioned separately.

INSURANCE & PUBLIC LIABILITY

Whilst every effort will be made to ensure the safety and security of the exhibition and the works in it, BAM will not accept liability for any loss or damage to artists' work whilst in the group's possession. Submissions are left at the artist's own risk and artists must arrange their own insurance cover.
